Dear Classic Car Enthusiast,

After a year of inaction due to Covid, **King's Lynn & District Motor Club** is offering you an early opportunity to get behind the wheel again as we invite you to enter our 43rd Annual Classic Car Rally. The event will again be run in aid of the **Norfolk Accident Rescue Service**.

Following some unprecedented times, KLDMC hopes we can again draw on the support received over many years from classic car owners across Norfolk and neighbouring counties. Our successful three venue format is retained for this event with an emphasis on driving our cars, enjoying the places we visit and sharing the day with other enthusiasts, all in a Covid-secure way with the help of our hosting venues.

Sponsorship helps keep our costs to a modest level and allows more funds to be raised for our charity. We are very grateful to Lyn & Rob George at **Anglia Car Auctions** for their continued backing as main sponsor. Our finish was last visited in 1999 by our rally: **Ickworth House** in Suffolk is a neoclassical building set in parkland. It is the former residence of the Marquess of Bristol before being sold to the National Trust in 1998. Here you will be able to visit the West Wing, its tea room and gift shop. We are hopeful there will also be access to the Rotunda.

Full details of the event are in the regulations which follow. We look forward to seeing you on **Sunday 4th July**.

EVENT REGULATIONS

1. **King's Lynn & District Motor Club Limited will organise its 43rd Annual Classic Car Rally, sponsored by Anglia Car Auctions, on Sunday, 4th July, 2021.**
2. The meeting will be run in accordance with Motor Sports UK regulations as a touring assembly, under certificate of permit exemption no. 121409. The meeting will be governed by the MSUK's General Regulations, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions issued for the event. An MSUK certificate of exemption from permit has been applied for.
3. **COVID-19: As a mass gathering, to meet MSUK regulations and as a general measure to protect the well-being of participants, we ask you to wear a face mask in all indoor areas of the event, even where social distancing can be achieved. The only exception will be when seated for eating and drinking indoors. In outdoor areas and in vehicles, masks are only required if appropriate social distancing cannot be achieved. These measures may be altered in accordance with national guidelines at the time of the event.**
4. This event is open to members and non-members of the promoting Club, with classic cars which are at least 15 years old. If you are aware of others who may wish to enter, please give them a copy of the entry form or refer them to the Club's website.
5. The event will raise funds in aid of the **Norfolk Accident Rescue Service (NARS, see panel below)** ▼
Donations will be at the discretion of the King's Lynn & DMC Committee and details will be published on the Club website.
6. Entries open on publication of these regulations and close on **Thursday 17th June 2021** or when the maximum entry is reached, if earlier. Maximum entry is 100 cars. Late entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be sent to **Peter Horsburgh, The Highlands, Sedgford Rd, Docking, Norfolk. PE31 8PN.**
7. Vehicle classes are: Veteran, Vintage & PVT (pre-1950); Historic Classic (1950-71); Post-Historic Classic (1972-87) and Modern Classic (1988-2006). The organisers reserve the right to adjust or amalgamate classes if necessary.
8. The event will start from **Downham Home & Garden**, Bexwell, PE38 0AD (on the A10 just south of the A10/A1122 roundabout; O.S. map ref 143/625028; www.downhamgardenstore.co.uk). Fuel is available close to the start on both the A10 and A1122.
9. Registration will take place on arrival at the start from 9.00am. Tea and coffee will be provided at the start and is included in the entry for all participants. Bacon rolls will also be available, kindly provided by our hosts, Downham Home & Garden.
10. **All entrants must sign the declaration at Registration to confirm that their car is road legal and that they have valid insurance for the event.**
11. Cars will leave the start from approximately 10.15 am on a suggested scenic route of c. 50 miles which will be provided to participants in the form of a road book with mileages and tulip diagrams. This will be supplemented with arrows, where appropriate.
12. Cars will be identified by numbered rally plates issued at registration which must be fixed to the front of each vehicle. Plastic tie straps will be supplied.
13. The lunch halt will be at **Lynford Hall Hotel**, Lynford Road, Mundford, Thetford IP26 5HW (O.S. map reference 132/819941; www.lynfordhallhotel.co.uk).
14. Cars will arrive at lunch from c. 12 noon. We have dedicated parking for all participants; please park as directed by our marshals.



NARS is a charity providing vital first response expert medical help at the scene of serious road crashes and other life-threatening medical emergencies. The doctors and paramedics who volunteer to NARS have received extra training to provide high level trauma care and can administer specialist drugs at the scene of a crash or cardiac arrest, vital during the critical moments of an incident. NARS receives no funding from the Government or the NHS. It relies entirely on the goodwill of the public to keep providing this crucial service.

15. A two-course hot lunch may be *pre-ordered* at the time of entry. Tea/coffee is also included. The vegetarian option is available on request – please tick the box on the entry form. Lunch is priced at £23/head. Menu:

16. Alternatively, entrants may bring a picnic. We have and access to a large grass area for picnickers, courtesy of **Forestry England** (see panel, right) ►
17. A licensed cash bar and toilet facilities will be available at the hotel for the use of all participants at the lunch halt.
18. Over lunch, judging of entrants will be by other competitors in their class for Class Award trophies (see clause 7) and for the *Adrian Flux Insurance* Shield for the overall winner voted as ‘Car of the Day’.
19. A representative from our beneficiaries NARS will select the winner of the *Anglia Car Auctions* Trophy for their choice of best car with popular appeal.
20. The KLDMC marshals will judge the Hillebrand Bos Memorial Trophy, awarded to the participants ‘Most Appropriately Attired’ for their vehicle. This award is open to all entrants; do please support it!
21. Cars leave the lunch halt at c. 1.45 pm and follow a suggested scenic route of c. 30 miles to reach the finish at approx. 3 pm.
22. The event will finish at the National Trust’s **Ickworth House**, Horringer, Bury St Edmunds (O.S. map reference 155/825619½, www.nationaltrust.org.uk/ickworth)
23. At the finish, entry - including admission to Ickworth House - will be by pre-paid passes provided in your entry pack.
24. If you are a member of the National Trust, please indicate this on your entry form to secure a £5 discount per person from the entry fee. **You will need to bring your membership card(s) with you to show at signing-on and again on entry to the park at Ickworth**; you will not need to present our pass.
25. The Presentation of Awards (to be held for a maximum of 12 months) will take place next to the cars at about **4.15pm** (or in an adjacent area in the event of wet weather).
26. The entry fee is **£27.50** per car. Please use the official entry form provided. Photocopies of the entry form are acceptable. Entries close on **Thursday 10th June 2021**.
27. Please pay for both your food order and entry fee at the time of entry but note that cheques will not be presented before 1st June. Alternatively, BACS is available; please see the entry form.
28. Acknowledgements of entry and final instructions will be sent to entrants by e-mail wherever possible so, if you have an e-mail address, please provide details on the entry form. Periodic updates will also appear on our event webpage at www.kingslynndmc.co.uk. Hard copy acknowledgements will be provided only if an SAE is included.
29. Final instructions will be issued by email or post from Monday 14th June 2021. All other information you need will be included in your entrant’s pack issued at registration at the start on the day.
