EVENT REGULATIONS

1. **King's Lynn & District Motor Club Limited will organise its 48th Annual Classic Car Rally on Sunday 26th July 2026.**
2. The meeting will be run in accordance with Motor Sports UK regulations as a touring assembly, under certificate of permit exemption no. 203239. The meeting will be governed by the MSUK's General Regulations, these supplementary regulations and any written instructions issued for the event. An MSUK Certificate of Exemption from permit has been issued.
3. This event is open to members and non-members of the promoting Club, with classic cars which are at least **15 years old**. If you are aware of others who may wish to enter, please give them a copy of the entry form or refer them to the Club's website.
4. The event will raise funds in aid of the **Norfolk Accident Rescue Service (NARS, see panel below)** ▼
Donations to be at the discretion of the King's Lynn & DMC Committee; details will be published on the Club website.
5. Entries open on publication of these regulations and close on **Friday 3rd July 2026** or when the maximum entry is reached, if earlier. The maximum entry is **80** cars. Late entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be sent to the Entries Secretary: **Peter Horsburgh, The Highlands, Sedgford Road, Docking, Norfolk. PE31 8PN.**
6. Other officials: *Clerk of the Course:* Adrian Cunnington; *Club Secretary:* Duncan Russell; *Club Chairman:* Paul Smalley; *Chief Marshals:* Mark Banham & Andy Congreve; *Club Treasurer:* Helen Haylock; *Logistics Officer:* David Ottoway; *Club Safeguarding Officer:* Stephen Tilburn.
7. Vehicle classes are: Vintage, PVT & Fifties (up to 1959); Historic Classic (1960-75); Post-Historic Classic (1976-90) and Modern Classic (1991-2011). The organisers reserve the right to adjust or amalgamate classes if necessary.
8. **The event will start from Norfolk Leisure, Garage Lane, Setchey, King's Lynn, PE33 0AX. OS map ref. 132/635137½; w3w///mint.lighters.slate).**
9. Fuel is available within 2 miles of the start at multiple outlets at West Winch and off Hardwick Road, King's Lynn.
10. Registration will take place on arrival at the start from 9.00 am. Tea, coffee and bacon rolls will be provided at the start and are included in the entry for all participants.
11. **All entrants must sign the declaration at Registration to confirm that their car is road legal and that they have valid insurance for the event.**
12. Cars will leave the start from approximately 10.00 am on a suggested scenic route of c. 50 miles which will be provided to participants in the form of a road book with mileages and tulip diagrams. This will be supplemented with arrows, where appropriate.
13. Cars will be identified by numbered rally plates issued at registration which must be fixed to the front of each vehicle. Plastic tie straps will be supplied.
14. The lunch halt will be at the award winning **Fox & Hounds** (South Norfolk Pub of the Year 2023 & 2024) at Frith Way, Great Moulton, NR15 2HE (<https://thefoxgreatmoulton.com>; OS map reference 144/168½904; what3words:///mend.spokes.soccer)



NARS is a charity that gives crucial and expert first response medical help at the scene of serious road crashes and other life-threatening medical emergencies. The doctors and paramedics who volunteer to NARS receive extra training to provide high level trauma care and can administer specialist drugs at the scene of a crash or cardiac arrest, vital during the critical moments of an incident.

NARS receives no funding from Government or the NHS. It relies wholly on the support of the public to sustain this incredible service.

15. Cars will arrive at the lunch halt at approx 11.45 am. Lunch will be served from 12.00 noon. There is a need to ensure we use space at the pub judiciously; please park as directed by our marshals.
16. A hot Sunday lunch may be *pre-ordered* at the time of entry at **£14.00 to £18.00** per head. Please indicate any dietary restrictions on the entry form. Alternatively, entrants may bring a picnic. A licensed cash bar and toilet facilities will be available in the marquee for the use of all participants.
17. Over lunch, judging of entrants will be by other competitors in their class for Class Award trophies (see para 7) and for the **Adrian Flux Insurance Shield** for the overall winner voted 'Car of the Day'.
18. A representative from our beneficiaries NARS, or their delegate, will select the winner of the **Anglia Car Auctions Trophy** for their choice of 'best car with popular appeal'.
19. The KLDMC marshals will judge the **Hillebrand Bos Memorial Trophy**, awarded to those participants 'Most Appropriately Attired' for their vehicle. This award is open to all entrants; please do support it by wearing something that is (or at least looks like it is) from your car's era if you can.
20. Cars will leave the lunch halt promptly by 1.30 pm and follow a suggested route of c. 40 miles to reach the finish by *approx.* 2.50 pm.
21. **The event will finish at Holkham Hall, entering via the south gate (www.holkham.co.uk; OS map reference 132/882½397¼; what3words:///shadowing.makes.mixture)**
22. At Holkham, please drive carefully through the park until you reach the main buildings, where we will park in front of the Hall. Please follow our marshals' instructions.
23. The Presentation of Awards (to be held for a maximum of 12 months) will take place next to the cars at about **4.15 pm**. *The Holkham facilities will remain open through to 5pm, apart from the visiting 'street food' outlets which close at 4pm. Please exit the Park by 5.30pm.*
24. The entry fee is **£35** per car. Please use the official entry form provided. Photocopies of the entry form are acceptable. Entries close on **Friday 3rd July 2026**.
25. Please pay for both your food order and entry fee at the time of entry if possible. **BACS payment is preferred**; please see the entry form and pay by **10th June** (or on your entry date if later).
26. Acknowledgements of entry and final instructions will be sent to entrants by e-mail wherever possible so, if you have an e-mail address, please provide details on the entry form. Periodic updates will also appear on our event webpage at www.kingslyndmc.co.uk. Hard copy acknowledgements will be provided only if an SAE is included.
27. Final instructions will be issued by email or post from Friday 10th July 2026. All other information you need will be included in your entrant's pack issued at Registration at the start on the day.
28. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event without notice, refuse entries or merge classes as necessary.
